⁹ “This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, **your will be done**, on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹ **Give us today our daily bread.** ¹² And **forgive us** our debts, as we also have forgiven **our debtors.** ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but **deliver us** from the evil one.
