

Earn While You Learn (EWYL) is a program offered for mothers and fathers at ABC Life Choices. Because of the overwhelming generosity of our donors, all services are at no cost to clients and are confidential. EW-YL offers opportunities for learning and personal growth as well as family wellness, while also providing 'ABC Cash' that can be used to purchase new and gently used items from the ABC Care Closet boutique shop. Clients work on lessons they want and at a pace that fits their timing. Lessons range from pregnancy and the developing baby to parenting skills, personal and relationship growth.

Care Closet items include maternity and baby clothes, blankets, diapers, formula, toys, books and much more. We may have items such as strollers, car seats and baby furniture, depending on seasonal donations.
