He rebirths us to new life Romans 8:11;

Think about the things you have learned from studying the scriptures and discussing the questions in this resource.

Do the following statements describe you?

- 1. Jesus the Christ is my Lord & Savior, and I want to love & obey Him forever. The Holy Spirit gives me the desire & ability to do this.
- 2. I need a Savior because of the sin that keeps me from relationship with God. I cannot earn His forgiveness & love; my sin has earned me a forever death.
- 3. The good news is that Jesus came, fully God & fully human, just like God promised in the scriptures. Jesus died on the cross in place of my sin, was raised from the dead & lives today to save all who turn from their sin and trust in Him.
- 4. My trust in Jesus is a gift from God, and I want to share my thankfulness for this gift by living for Jesus.
- 5. I understand baptism is a public confession, to the world and to the Church, of my surrender to Jesus as Lord, dying to my own ideas & sinful ways, resurrecting to new life with Christ by the power of the same Holy Spirit who raised Him from the dead.
