This last year our family has been praying about and contemplating what the best long term housing situation will be for my (Michael's) parents. About two years ago Wayne and Cindy decided that Alaska was where they would like to make their permanent residence. With my father beginning to exhibit signs of Alzheimer's/Dementia we knew we would have to find housing fairly close to where we live so that we could help Mom care for Dad as he continues to need more help. After considering many different options, Mom and Dad decided we should build a small house on our property. This will make it much easier for our family to help care for my Dad while at the same time giving my parents their own place to live independently. In building on our property we can also make use of our existing utilities and water well, allowing us to save on construction costs.

This winter, we started building a 24' x 32' home with a small loft on the edge of our 2.5 acre property. We have been tackling this project as time allows, with the help of many friends and volunteers. During the first week of June, we had a wonderful group of six men come from one of our supporting churches to give us a much needed hand. The team hailed from Riverview Church located in Pine River, MN.
