"Ministering to the homeless men of the Kenai Peninsula"

A few newsletters back, we shared how ABC Life Choices had been asked to partner with a local faith-based addiction recovery ministry called Freedom House. Not long after those classes started, we got another call from an organization called Friendship Mission.

Friendship Mission has a very interesting history. Prior to being used for ministry purposes, the building was used as a brothel, bar and liquor store. In 2004, a couple, feeling guided by the Holy Spirit, purchased the dilapidated property for \$2,000!



In 2005, Friendship Mission opened its doors in a limited capacity to men who are homeless, coming out of a prison environment or just needing help getting back on their feet. With lots of hard work and countless volunteer hours, a progressive remodel of the facility was completed in 2012. Friendship Mission is now capable of housing up to 12 men at a time. While providing a safe place to live, directors Rich and Cami Zifko strive to show men the love of Christ through discipleship, Bible studies and lots of prayer!

It was such a privilege for myself, (Mike), and another ABC volunteer, David, to be able to spend time with these men as we went through an anger management class called "Overcoming Emotions that Destroy." We love to partner with other ministries in the area! As we join in the blessing of sharing the Gospel through leading various men's classes, I am constantly reminded of the need for the Gospel to go forth and take hold in people's lives. Satan uses many different stumbling blocks and obstacles to bring about chaos. The only answer to these challenges is a personal relationship with Jesus Christ!
