On September 1, 2022, I delivered 37 dresses and 37 purses to Rachel at Dressa Girl Headquarters in Forest City, Iowa. I started making dresses after my mom passed away in 2020. My mom, Darlene Mishek, liked the idea of pillowcase dresses after I told her about 100-year-old Eva's story about Operation Christmas Child that I had watched on Facebook. When I found a bolt of beautiful red floral fabric in my mom's house, I decided to do something productive with it in her memory. I made my first pillowcase dress one year ago, in September 2021. I then shared my project idea with a friend. She joined me and made two dresses. Another friend, Ellen Shamas-Brandt, joined me this last summer and made ten dresses and many drawstring purses. We also presented our project at our sewing machine store in Littleton, Colorado where four more ladies joined us in making more dresses and purses. I received all the dresses and purses, and I packed them in one suitcase. I flew to St. Paul, Minnesota for a family reunion at the end of August 2022. During the trip to Minnesota, I took a road trip to Forest City, Iowa where I delivered the dresses to Rachel at the Dress a Girl headquarters. I had a wonderful visit with Rachel and two other ladies there and enjoyed a fascinating tour of the facility. Ellen and I are very excited to continue our work as co-ambassadors for Dress a Girl. We have already received donated fabric from very generous people in our area to make many dresses and purses for the girls. We have other ladies interested in helping with this cause and I'm very excited to see where this project goes. I am so honored to be a coambassador of this amazing organization.







BROWNIE FRIDGE CAKE!



Brownie Fridge Cake!

Jordan wowed us all last serve day by making this super delicious cake! Everyone wanted the recipe and we thought maybe you would too!

- 1 Box Brownie Mix
- 1 Large Egg
- 1 8oz Cream Cheese, Softened
- 1 Cup Powdered Sugar
- 2 8 oz Whipped Topping
- 1 3 oz Instant Vanilla Pudding
- 3 1/2 C Milk
- 1 Hershey Bar or Syrup

Mix brownie mix according to instructions. Add the egg and bake. Let cool

Mix cream cheese, powdered sugar and one of the whipped toppings. Spread over brownies.

Blend puddings and milk. Spread on top of cream cheese mixture.

Top with other whipped topping. Pour syrup or shaved chocolate over the top.
