God Plans for People: Jesus is God's Plan for Us, Genesis 37; 39-45 LESSON:

**BIG IDEA:** Jesus is God's plan for me. Bell, Bunny & Bag **GATHER/PREP:** 

**OPENING:** (ring the bell and gather for circle time)

My friend was not being nice to me today.

He took the toy I was playing with and it hurt my feelings.

So, here is my PLAN, first I'm going to yell at him and hit him

then I will push him and call him a bad name...

(Bunny pops out) Oh, hey Bunny! I was just telling them about my plan...

(Bunny whispers) Oh, really? I'm sorry everyone. Bunny says my plan is bad.

Do you have a better plan for me kids?

What are some good things to do if someone takes your toy? (children)

Wow, those are some great plans.

Thank you kids and thank you Bunny. I'll do those things instead.

(Bunny leaves)

In today's account from the Bible, some boys have a bad plan for a brother,

but God's plan is always good...

LESSON: Read Joseph's Brothers Sell Him, The Beginner's Gospel Story Bible p.38

Was Joseph's brothers' plan good or bad?

But God's plan is always ... good or bad?

Guess what?!!! God's good plan for you is ALWAYS JESUS!.

Joseph's brothers were mean to Joseph and gave him up for money, Jesus was betrayed and they killed him on a cross.

BUT God's plan was good, and on the 3rd day Jesus was raised back to life.

Now, by believing in Jesus, we can be saved and be with him forever.

Repeat after me... Jesus (children) is God's plan (children) for me (children)

### Review:

• Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. (Revelation 1:17)

Actions: Do not (Wag your finger like "no, no")

be afraid (make a scared face with hands on cheeks)

I am (ASL for Jesus, use middle fingers to point to holes in hands)

the first (#1 with finger)

and the Last (hands flat and down crisscross, like "No way!")

• May peace be with you! The Father has sent me. So now I am sending you. (John 20:21)

Actions: May peace (Both hands on heart)

be with you (point toward others)

The Father has sent me (Raise hands to the sky)

So now I am sending you (Pretend to throw a ball or paper airplane)

• The Scriptures you study are about me... come to me and receive life. (John 5:39-40)

Actions: The Scriptures you study (Make your hands look like an opening book)

are about me (Point up to Jesus)

Come to me (Raise hands to praise Jesus)

and receive life (Hands in front of you like catching a big ball)
